6:00 PM – 8:30PM

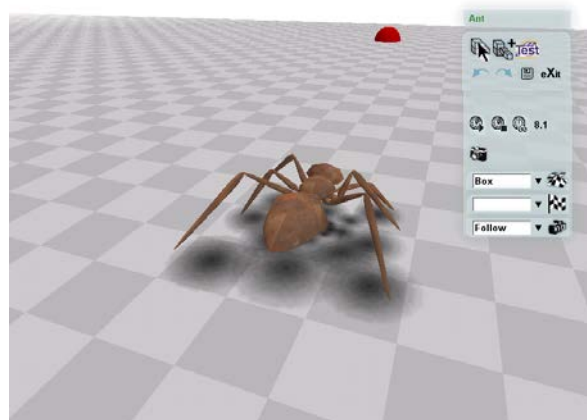
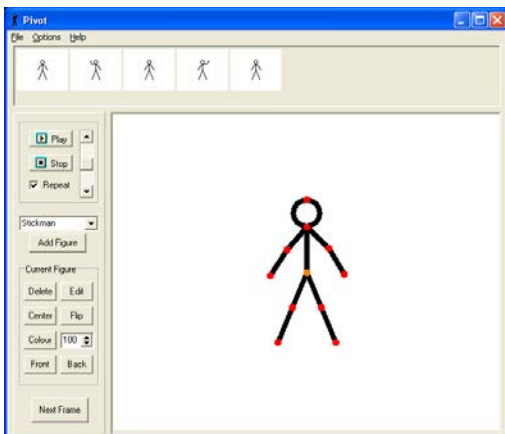
Place: Seacoast School of Technology
