Dear Epping School Staff,

The Epping School District is working closely with the NH Department of Health and Human Services and the Greater Exeter Region Public Health Network to help administer the H1N1 flu vaccine. Epping School District is planning to host an H1N1 flu vaccination clinic. It is important to note that although the Epping School District has recently gone through the flu cycle, we have been told that there may continue to be flu cycles throughout the school year.

The date is not yet confirmed, however, all staff members are eligible to attend the clinic. Please read the vaccine information sheets attached to this letter. Once you have read the information sheets, fill out the Consent Form and return it to the school by **January 12th**. The consent form is also available on the District Website at [www.sau14.org](http://www.sau14.org).

The H1N1 vaccine is free. You will be notified when the clinic will occur.

- Injectable vaccine is for anyone over 50 and those with medical conditions.
- Intranasal mist (nasal spray) is for those who are healthy, not pregnant and age 49 or under.

**If you do not fill out the Consent form completely, you will not be given the vaccine.**
