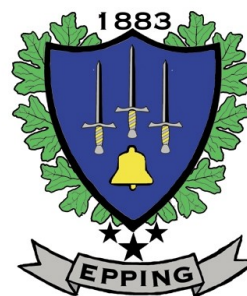

## Class Rank and GPA

A student's *Grade Point Average (GPA)* is determined by multiplying the grade point value by the credits earned for each individual class, totaling the grade points earned, and then dividing the total grade points earned by the total attempted. This calculation is used to determine a student's *Class Rank* as well. Both *Class Rank* and *GPA* are weighted using the GPA Scale.

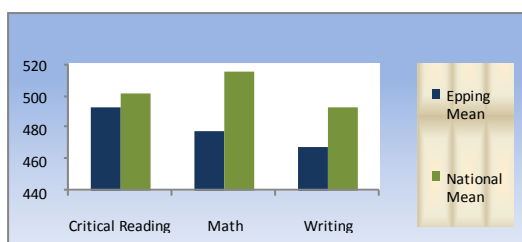
