

## **BBBA – BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS**

To become a candidate for the School Board, a person must be a registered voter in the district. No person holding the office School Board member shall at the time hold the office of school district moderator, treasurer, or auditor. No person employed on a salaried basis by the Epping School District shall be a School Board member. Salaried positions include administrative, teaching, and support positions.

Candidates for the School Board should be mindful that the position requires significant time, effort and commitment to the school and community. Individuals who do not feel they will be able to provide significant time, effort, and commitment are discouraged from seeking candidacy.

The same qualifications shall exist when the School Board seeks to fill vacancies.
