

## **IKC- GRADE REPORTING & CLASS RANK FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

This policy is intended to encourage Epping High School Students to take the most challenging of courses available without penalizing those students for doing so.

GRADING POLICIES - Grade point average (GPA) and class rank are weighted based on the chart below.

WEIGHTED GRADE POINT AVERAGE - A student's GPA is determined by multiplying the grade point value by the credits earned for each individual class, totaling the grade points earned, and then dividing the total grade points earned by the total credits attempted.

WEIGHTED CLASS RANK – Class rank shall be a composite of grades earned in high school, grades 9 to 12. Class rank shall be determined by using a weighted grade point average by putting the GPA's of all students in a class in rank order from highest to lowest. In the year of graduation, ranking in a class would be based on the eligible quarter grades.

Grades transferred from schools where class rank is determined by a different system shall be converted to the Epping School District's ranking system. Grades earned in Epping-sponsored summer school, other School Principal approved courses offered outside of Epping High School, and School Principal approved courses at institutions of higher learning (dual enrollment) shall be included in the calculation of class rank. Courses at institutions of higher learning shall receive the same quality points as honors and advanced placement courses.
