

JFAA – ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

All new resident students, accompanied by parent or guardian, should register at school before opening day and as early as possible.

Children entering school for the first time must have proof of physical examination, immunization records, a copy of the child's birth certificate, and proof of residency satisfactory to the Superintendent or his/her designee. Principals or their designees will meet with new children and parents to introduce them to the school and to explain school programs.
