

JIC – SCHOOL CONDUCT

We expect all of our school community, including students, to:

1. Support the individual in determining his or her learning purposes and the means for achieving them.
2. Provide a rigorous educational program to promote success for all learners.
3. Balance the educational program with real world and service learning.
4. Be engaged in the learning process by setting high expectations and collaborating with others to meet these expectations.
5. Respect the right to learn for all and at all times.
6. Be responsible for one's own learning and encourage the learning of others.
7. Behave in an appropriate manner considerate of one's self and the community.
8. Be accountable for one's actions and choices.
9. Be truthful, courteous, and take pride in one's work.
10. Be present and on time.

These principles guide all members of the school community. All members of the school community have the responsibility to know and respect the rules and regulations of the school and to behave in a manner appropriate to one's self as well as other members of the school community. All school community members shall receive annually at the opening of school a publication listing the rules and regulations to which they are subject. Such publication will be made available in another language or presented orally upon request. The school community includes students, parents, teachers, staff, administration, and community members.
