

JJE - STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

The Board recognizes that students may wish to engage in fundraising activities.

Fund-raising projects in which students canvass the public, off school grounds, in connection with school events and school-connected money-raising activities, will be kept to a minimum.

It shall be the duty of the School Principal to consider all requests for fund-raising and to approve or deny each request. The School Principal shall develop an annual fund-raising plan. Revisions to this plan shall be presented through the Superintendent for School Board approval.

When such fund-raising results in a public gift to the school, the gift must be accepted by the School Board.

Fund-raising for non-school purposes will not be permitted on school grounds unless there is some educational merit to the fund-raising activity as determined by the School Principal.

All fundraising money must be deposited in the school activity accounts which shall be maintained according to standards and procedures established by the Superintendent or designee, and these accounts shall be audited annually.
