

JLCG – EXCLUSION OF STUDENTS FROM SCHOOL FOR ILLNESS

A student may be excluded from the classroom when he/she exhibits symptoms of a contagious or communicable illness. The School Nurse is responsible for determining whether a student should be excluded from school for such an illness. Parents will be notified if their child is excluded from school for such an illness and provided with criteria for readmission.

The School Nurse is to notify the School Principal if a contagious or communicable illness in his/her opinion is having an impact on the whole school or has the potential to impact the whole school. The School Nurse working with the School Principal shall determine a course of action to negate the effects of this illness. The School Nurse shall consult with the Department of Health and Human Services Disease Control. The School Principal is to notify the Superintendent of this situation. The Superintendent in consultation with the school and state agencies may elect to close the school for health reasons.
