EPPING SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES  
JANUARY 14, 2012

The Epping School Board met in the Epping Town Hall to act on a petition warrant article, attend the public hearing, and take any action following the public hearing. The meeting was called to order at 8:32 pm. In attendance were School Board Members Gregory Dodge, Dave Mylott, Jeff Harris, Sue Kimball, and Brian Reed, Business Administrator Martha Williamson, and Superintendent Barbara Munsey.

The Board discussed the following petition article.

“Citizens’ petition per T. Kucera, J. Comeau, T. Dwyer Jr., et al. To see if the school district will vote to keep in place the elementary School Library/Media Specialist position and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$79,523.00, which includes salary and benefits, for this position. This will ensure that the Elementary School Library continues to be managed and staffed by a full-time Librarian/Media Specialist.”

*Jeff Harris made a motion to recommend the petition warrant article, seconded by Dave Mylott. The motion failed 0-5-0. It was further clarified that on the warrant the recommendation would read that the School Board does not recommend this article 5-0-0.*

*Gregory Dodge made a motion to recess the meeting to attend the public hearing, seconded by Dave Mylott. The motion passed 5-0 and the meeting recessed at 8:41 am to attend the hearing.*

Following the public hearing the meeting was called to order at 10:28 am. The following action by the Budget Committee required no action by the School Board.

- Recommend Teachers’ Agreement by a vote of 9-0-1 (recused members - 1)
- Recommend Budget by a vote of 10-0-1 (recused members - 0)
- Not to recommend Citizens’ Petition by a vote of 5-2-2 (recused members - 2)

*Dave Mylott made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jeff Harris. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned.*
