EPPING SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES  
JULY 6, 2009

The Epping School Board met in public session per the posted agenda. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm in the SAU Office. In attendance were School Board Members Gregory Dodge, Shawn Patton, and David Mylott and Superintendent Barbara Munsey.

MANIFEST – Gregory Dodge reviewed the following manifests.

Dave Mylott made a motion to approve Vendor Manifest #24 dated 06/30/09 in the amount of \$177,714.47, seconded by Shawn Patton. The motion was approved 3-0.

Dave Mylott made a motion to approve Vendor Manifest #1 dated 07/02/09 in the amount of \$202,762.82, seconded by Shawn Patton. The motion was approved 3-0.

Dave Mylott made a motion to approve Payroll Manifest #26 dated 06/26/09 in the amount of \$321,463.19, seconded by Shawn Patton. The motion was approved 3-0.

Dave Mylott made a motion to approve Payroll Manifest #1 dated 07/10/09 in the amount of \$108,573.34, seconded by Shawn Patton. The motion was approved 3-0.

PERSONNEL – Superintendent Munsey presented the following resignation and nominations.

Shawn Patton made a motion to accept the resignation of Jenifer Fitt, EHS Math Teacher with regret, seconded by Dave Mylott. The motion passed 3-0. David Mylott questioned if exit interviews were conducted by the School Board and it was recommended that this be discussed at the next meeting.

Shawn Patton made a motion to accept the nomination of Karen Page for the EES Reading Teacher Position, Kara Reynolds for the EMS Math/Science/Reading Grade 6 Position, and Joanne Reed for the EHS Special Education Teacher Position, seconded by David Mylott. The motion passed 3-0.

Gregory Dodge questioned the hiring for the summer custodial position. The Superintendent reported that there was a job description and sort criteria. It was recommended that this also be discussed at the next meeting.

OTHER – Shawn Patton questioned if the district had received bids for field mowing as the intent was to evaluate having this work contracted or having the district purchase a tractor. It was recommended that this also be discussed at the next meeting.

ADJOURNMENT – Shawn Patton made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by David Mylott. The meeting was adjourned at 6:23 pm.
