

CB - SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT

The duties of the Superintendent are defined per the employment contract, School Board policies, State Statutes, and New Hampshire Department of Education Rules.

The Board expects that the Superintendent is responsible for:

1. The execution of Board policies,
2. The management of the work of all schools, the duties of which, apart from those required by law, the Superintendent shall assign.
3. The observance of all Board policies by all those persons employed by the district.
4. The enforcement of all provisions of the law relating to the operation of the schools or other educational, social and recreational agencies, or activities under the charge of the Board.
