

CBG - SUPERINTENDENT'S DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The Board encourages the Superintendent to make every effort to stay abreast of educational trends and to seize opportunities for exploring new ideas and programs that may be used to advantage in the School District.

For the benefit of the entire school system, the Board encourages the Superintendent to set aside time each year to attend certain seminars and conferences and visit other school systems in which promising ideas are emerging, as these activities are delineated in the Superintendents individual employment contract. The Superintendent shall share his/her experiences and knowledge with school administrators and professional colleagues. This shall be in the form of a written summary, report, or a presentation (with an audio or video recording) at a regular staff meeting or professional development event. A package including copies of relevant materials obtained at the original event will be submitted to the Superintendent's Office for recording and filing.
