

EBCB – FIRE DRILLS

Fire drills will be scheduled by the Principal(s) each month during the school year. Fire drills will also be scheduled during the summer months for summer school sessions.

The purpose of a fire drill is to train students, under staff direction, to move safely, quickly, and quietly from any location within the building to an assigned evacuation area outside.

Drills will be executed at different hours of the day and during various activities.

Students, staff, and visitors will not be allowed to obtain clothing after the alarm is sounded.

School staff and appointed students will be assigned responsibilities for the proper execution of such drills. Rules for fire evacuation will be posted in each room. The exercise will be observed, recorded, and reported by the School Principal.

Each class or group will proceed to the predetermined point outside the building and remain there while a check is made to see that all are accounted for, leaving only when a recall signal is given to return to the building or when dismissed.
