

Reopening Task Force
August 31, 2020

1. Updates from Superintendent
 - a. CHaD Recommendations - endorsed students returning to school
 - b. Survey - Initial Results
 - i. 85% of families surveyed will be sending students to school in-person
 - ii. 40% will take the bus and 60% will be dropped off
 - iii. 58% of students will participate in in (a)synchronous learning through Epping
 - iv. 82% of students with IEP services will come in for in-person services
 - v. 48% of parents of students with IEP's would prefer remote meetings
2. Home Screening Update
 - a. CDC does not currently recommend universal symptom screenings
 - b. Parents or caregivers should be strongly encouraged to monitor their children for signs of infectious illness
 - c. Students who are sick should not attend school in-person
 - d. We will be using the honor system in phase 3; if we go to phase 2
 - e. It would be good to send home a reminder sheet with families
 - f. Staff will continue to do the screening
 - g. Sports - need to discuss with Ben further; those students are in closer contact
 - h. Add QR code to the website in an easy to find location
3. Phase 2 - Update
 - a. Focus is on student need
 - b. Building open to those who need services and supports
 - c. Students who most need in-person supports will be invited
 - d. Will all staff or just some staff be teaching remotely from school?
 - e. Consider adding supports for those students who really struggled with remote learning.
 - f. Suggestion: MTSS teams can help create the lists.
 - g. Suggestion: Ask Epping Rec to help with childcare. They have had difficulty staffing the program.
 - h. Think about essential workers.
 - i. Would students be there for shorter time periods.
 - j. Think about how paraeducators could be best utilized.
 - k. Some teachers would prefer to do the remote from the classroom.
 - l. Make every effort to meet compensatory education requirements.
 - m. Make an effort to support those families who are at-risk.
 - n. Need to have some flexibility around grouping.
 - o. How would it look?
 - p. Need to have better connection with parents if a student is falling behind - standardized expectations.
