1. DHHS New Guidance Consideration (for close contacts and those who traveled) -
 - a. Decreasing quarantine period from 14 to 10 days
 - b. Meghan Young - Our DHHS representative (Boudu) shared that we should continue to use the 14 day period because we are not able to socially distance
 - c. Dave - we should continue to follow CDC guidelines
 - d. Melanie - social emotional impact should be considered
 - e. The group decided to stay with the 14 day period
