- 12 Student Cases/0 Staff Cases since start of school 4 New Cases since last meeting
- 1 possible case of school transmission since start of school
- 15 Active Cases in Epping (On October, 2021)
- 26 New Cases in Epping last 14 days Substantial Transmission

No New State Numbers

- Next Meeting October 6, 2021
- 25 new clusters (all but 2 are active)
- Total # of infections associated with clusters: 146
 - Children: 135 (92%)
 - Staff: 11 (8%)
- Average # of cases per cluster: 6 (range 3 16)

 community transmission currently statewide (preventing
 COVID-19 transmission)
