COVID-19 Isolation and Quarantine Guidance: Updated January 24, 2022

Based on guidance from the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services

Per guidance provided by the New Hampshire DHHS, **a household contact** is defined as any person who lives or sleeps in the same indoor shared space as another person diagnosed with COVID-19 (either a temporary or permanent living arrangement) leading to exposure to the person with COVID-19.
