- Vaccine on Friday still waiting for the link/additional information; we do not know if the second shot day
  - Protocols do change re: quarantine 14 days after the second vaccine (CDC info: <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/fully-vaccinated.html</u>)
  - Are extra vaccines available to family members?
  - Pfizer is doing trials on a child vaccine
  - Planning for staff to be sick after second shot
- Effectiveness of social distancing may end up changing from 6 to 3 feet
- Remote Fridays should we consider removing some?
  - Reasons for having remote Friday haven't change
  - Students would have a hard time with this decision (high school)
  - 5 or 6 Fridays after the full vaccination schedule
  - Group agrees no change at this time
- Remote numbers are declining (elementary = 8%)
- Remote after April vacation?
  - Four classrooms impacted after February
  - Would be tough to keep the kids motivated
  - Elementary has the most infected and affected
  - Group agrees that there is not sufficient evidence to be remote after vacation
  - Will look at how we are doing things at the elementary level to mitigate
- End of Year Events:
  - Prom & Graduation: both are a go with precautions (LaBelle in Derry)
  - 8th Grade Celebration need to finalize plans; something outside food and super fun stuff; bonfire, music, food truck;
  - Something for parents to attend? High school gym
